- Peripancreatic fluid collections
 - Common sequelae of pancreatitis
 - Symptomatic ones or infected collections need drainage
 - Solid necrosus needs debridement

Definition of fluid collections


| | Not Encapsulated (< 4 weeks) | Encapsulated (> 4 weeks) |
|------------------|--|--------------------------------|
| Liquid only | <i>Acute peripancreatic collection</i> | <i>Pseudocyst</i> |
| Liquid and solid | <i>Acute necrotic collection</i> | <i>Walled off necrosis</i> |

Both can be sterile or infected


A Acute peripancreatic fluid collections



Pseudocysts




Acute necrotic collections



Walled-off necrosis




